Merry Christmas! I know that is not the usual greeting you expected to hear from me in November and I can safely say that a few groans might have come out as well. So, why am I talking about Christmas already? This year, Advent starts on Sunday, December 1st and with the December newsletter not arriving with enough time, I wanted to share the exciting news of what we have planned for Advent this year. The theme will be looking at the birth story of Jesus and the birth story for a world that was hungry, both then and now.

Hunger is a universal human experience, drawing attention to our most basic needs for food and nourishment and our more complex needs—peace, liberation, and meaning in this life. So, it's no wonder that the story of Jesus—the one who came to feed the hungry—begins, ends, and centers around food. From the Manger gathers around the birth story in Luke 2, embracing the playful symbolism of a newborn Jesus being laid down to sleep in a feeding trough in a town called "House of Bread." Beginning Advent with the birth of Jesus may feel a bit unconventional. Still, we hope this liturgical difference will invite you to reflect on the life-sustaining hope, peace, joy, and love Jesus brings and notice how the baby born in a bread town continues to feed a hungry world today. – Illustrated Ministry

For the past 14 years, we've provided clothes, hygiene products, household items, and toys to families who otherwise might not have gifts to open on Christmas.



During Advent from December 1 – December 24, each congregation will be collecting food items for a local food pantry. Starting **December 1**st, both congregations can begin bringing items in. Please prayerfully consider supporting your congregation's chosen pantry.



St. Peter Church will be collecting for *Athens Circle of Joy*. Circle of joy serves the Athens area alongside their partner in Edgar that serves the Marathon City / Edgar area. They help to provide emergency food items as well as food vouchers to help offset food and personal care needs.

Trinity will be collecting for *The Neighbor's Place* in Wausau. Neighbor's Place serves the Wausau area's many needs of the community from furniture to household items as well as being a hub for food distribution. Neighbor's Place has an on-site food pantry as well as a central location where food items go out to other food pantries in the Wausau and Mosinee area.

Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church Council Meeting Summary October 14, 2024

Treasurer's Report - September 2024

General Fund: \$6,933.43Memorial Fund: \$164,080.66-includes value of 3 CDs=\$128,961.59Income: \$9,418.57Expenses: \$17,681.45

Pastor's Report

- Pastor received 2 letters from Paul & Faye & Marcus Zernicke to transfer membership
- The Advent Theme will be From the Manger around the Bread of Life. This will tie into a congregation food drive. The council agreed on the Neighbor's Place to donate the food to do.
- Discussion on caroling in December-Will need a volunteer to coordinate this event. Will need 2 groups because of the opposite sides of town some of our shut-ins live.
 - * Youth Group will prepare goodie packages to be delivered during this event.
 - * Possible date is Saturday, December 14th (Youth Group Bake sale will be December 15th)
- Parsonage Oven-In November 2022 Pastor had issues. This is an older oven. The oven is again having
 issues. A new oven has been ordered. The other item that needs replacement is the vent above the
 stove. This vent is the original vent in the house (1968) and needs to be replaced. *New vent has been
 ordered
- Communion table-initially was set up in front of the altar for the summer. Looking for a solid wood table preferably with 4 legs and a shelf underneath it or at least open through middle so you can see the parament on the altar behind it. Additional research will be done on the cost of tables and asking to see if we have any congregation members that could craft a table.

Old Business

- Property Review Recap-We are working on typing up notes to include pictures from our walk through. The Property Team will review to begin prioritizing needed projects and address concerns.
- Church Use Rental Agreement- The Bylaws state that "in the case of a request or occasional use, approval shall require a majority vote of the Congregation Council." The Property Team and Council are reviewing the Rental Agreement and exploring options for the future.

New Business

- Bylaw Updates: The latest version of the Constitution was ratified January 23, 2022. It was meant to be a combined Constitution and Bylaws. Some discussion around all the bylaws being fully incorporated into the ratified Constitution.
 - * Getting a committee together to review the Constitution and Bylaws to work on any proposed revisions needed.
