### ST. PETER EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH COUNCIL MEETING SUMMARY - April 7, 2025

### Pastor's Report:

- <u>Upcoming reminders</u> April 21-26th pastor will be on vacation.
  - \* April 27th Sunday will be blessing farm and fields.
  - \* May 4th New member Sunday
  - \* May 18 blessing of graduates
  - \* June 8 Affirmation of Baptism service.
- Adult confirmation Pastor looking at putting together this fall a small catechism course for adults
  reviewing Lutheran's catechism. Trying to find a mixture of individuals whether new to Lutheran
  faith or have been involved in Lutheran faith and interested in going through it again. Thinking it
  would be 4-5 weeks, about an hour each session. Will table for fall.

### **Old Business:**

- <u>Building Maintenance</u> (Roof <u>Update</u>, removal of things) **Roof:** Quality Homes will be dropping off material on Tuesday, April 7, 2025 and plan to start on roof Wednesday, April 9th. Hoping to be done in 2-3 days. Entry ways: Entry way to south is finished, there is a new floor on the bottom and put wooden steps down. Entry on North side is holding up well, no mold. **Wood cross:** The wooden cross will be taken down when the roof people are up there.
- <u>Joint summer service</u> Looking for 2 people from each church to form and be a committee (looking at dates, music, details, etc). It is in the bulletin that we are looking for volunteers.
- Fellowship Hall rental fee Discussed right now, with \$100 fee (\$50 fee + \$50 security deposit), the \$50 fee should go to church to cover extra costs such as snow removal, extra electricity and heat. If cleaning was needed, then the security deposit would not get returned and would then go to the janitorial service. Discussed if we would give a key for rentals or if we would someone come to open/lock up. Only members are allowed to rent the church. Made a motion to raise the cost of the rental of the church to \$100 plus \$50 security deposit (\$150 total) with \$50 returned to renter if church in appropriate condition.
- <u>Directory Update</u> The directory committee received 2 proofs that have been edited so far, thinking will have final version by the end of the week to edit again.
- <u>Time & Talent surveys</u> We got about 40 returned. Those will go to Wendy to be entered on a spreadsheet. We will continue to keep surveys on hand.
- <u>Financial system update</u> Utilizing Excel to recreate lost files to January 1, 2025 to current. In future, It is being backed up anytime something is updated. A motion to give \$500 for contracted services for updating the financial records. Motion passed.
- Annual report errors There is an inaccurate balance reported on page 9 of Annual Report (on ending balance). The ending balance didn't include additional funds. Note of the inaccurate number and will put in the correct one for the next annual meeting. The chili supper last year had donations included in expenses and should not have been. Will correct going forward and note that this will make comparison from 2024 to 2025 to be a little off.
- Roof expense update/loan pay down To date received \$33,911.68. Once we pay our final bill to AQH, will have \$25,492.43 allocated for roof specifically available assuming no unexpected expenses. Once the final payment comes through, we can consider a principal reduction on the loan. Will wait until next month to see what our final cost is.

- Patio Area-Discussion on building a covering for the patio area. The Council is open to ideas/discussion
  on a vision for the area. The Council wants to see if patio gets used more this year and how it is used
  before further discussion on building a covering or what is needed.
- Time & Talent Survey-Trinity considering on doing this again.
- Communion-new single cups have been ordered and are being utilized.
- Summer Joint Worship Service-St. Peter's-Scott Grund and Trinity-Bobby Dehnel volunteered to help.

### **New Business**

The Property Committee, Spring cleanup-will review church grounds to see what needs to be done.

- Looking for feedback on Lent services and if there were items that people liked or disliked that should be considered for future services.
- Possibility of a Blessing of animals service-fall time frame (was last done in September 2018).
- Received a letter from Compassus (hospice care center). They have chaplains that provide spiritual support for those in hospice and their families. Compassus would like to come to Trinity and give a little speech about what hospice is and what services they provide. Council agreed that we should pursue this opportunity and will put it on the agenda for the August meeting to set a date.

### **Old Business**

- Time & Talent Survey-Reviewed draft version of survey for Trinity. Council decided that this would be
  done in October. The form will be reviewed and finalized in August/September. It will be made into a
  pdf fillable form so it can be easily completed and emailed back.
- Summer Joint Worship Service-Committee is Scott Grund & Jackie Dehnel (from St. Peter's), and Connie Nikolai and Bobby Dehnel (from Trinity). Date is set for July 27<sup>th</sup> and the Mount Calvary Band (5 piece band) will be performing. Looking for other volunteers to help with the service and food. Possibly doing pulled pork. Planning for food for 150 people.

### ST. PETER EVANGELICAL LUTHERAN CHURCH COUNCIL MEETING SUMMARY - May 5, 2025

### Pastor's Report:

- <u>Lent</u> Just finished lent and everything went well. During season of lent, changed up worship services. Let Pastor know if there are things people liked and would like continued.
- Upcoming reminders -
  - \* May 12- Mother's Day will have a baptism.
  - \* May 18 blessing of graduates so far no names given for St. Peter, but will do general blessing.
  - \* June 8 Affirmation of Baptism service.
  - \* For confirmation, will have confirmation gifts be ordered, that will cost approximately \$150 coming out of Milestone Ministry Fund. This year we will have 5 confirmands.

### **Old Business:**

- <u>Building Maintenance</u> Old Cross: Discussed we would like to keep the old rugged cross look, but it will
  need the moss and lichen off and it would need to be sealed. Basement: Will need to discuss the East
  basement wall in the future. The wall moves and will eventually need to be looked at. It also leaks water.
- <u>Joint summer service</u> Agreed on date July 27, 2025 with 9:30 am. service and meal to follow. The children will be involved in singing as VBS will be over at that time. We have a booked band that has no fee. The band will be reaching out to Pastor and the committee organizing. Looking at smoked pulled pork for the meal and will have some desserts and other things ordered in. Last year we had 110 people (which is more than originally signed up). Will start asking for volunteers. Will reach out to Wendy to get this into the bulletin.
- <u>Directory Update</u> Trinity is still in the revision stage and ours has final approval. Hoping to have all approvals in by June and potentially have books by July.
- Roof expense update/loan pay down Currently we are applying \$300 per week toward the loan. A motion to put \$20,000 down additionally on the principal toward roof.
- <u>Constitution and Bylaws update</u> Working to format and pull all of the procedures into the Continuing
  Resolution section and hopes to have this back to us in the next few weeks so it can be sent to the Synod
  Office for review.
- <u>Treasurer error</u> Related to chili supper, there was \$950 in total donations included as profit that was transferred to the Building fund. Asked if this should be returned to the General fund where it should have stayed or just leave in the Building Fund. Agreed it should be put back into the General fund.

### **New Business:**

- <u>Daycare location</u> St. John's Christian Daycare is closing July 1, 2025. Discussion if St. Peter would be an option for potential new location, but not sure if our building would qualify. The daycare would provide some money back to the church potentially. They have about 30 kids. Would need a playground area. Age range is from infants to school age. Discussed we have funerals at times, water issues and chili supper set up is a week long. Discussed concerns with space at St. Peter (there are not separate rooms for different age groups and no extra storage space...). Motion we are not interested in pursuing a daycare at St. Peter at this time. Motion passed.
- Marathon County Health Department/Water quality received mail from Marathon County Health
  Department regarding nitrate level in water Have to have 2 consecutive levels below appropriate levels
  to be cleared/good and our last test was in August, which was good, but now we have to wait another
  year. We have to put a notice and a placard next to each water source. There are already notices
  posted, but not the signed placard. Will copy/laminate notice and post.

### **Greece & Türkiye Presentation**



St. Peter New Roof Update

In early April, the roof project was completed by American Quality Homes (AQH) and the final payment of \$28,584.50 was paid April 13<sup>th</sup>.

Through April 30th, roof project contributions totaled \$34,776.68, 61% of the total expense and the loan balance equaled \$47,870.33, with weekly payments of \$300 being applied. At the May 5th Church Council meeting, a motion was passed to apply \$20,000 of our remaining available roof funds towards the principal balance of the loan. In addition to this, a \$5,000 member contribution was received recently and also applied to the principal balance of the loan. The loan balance, as of May 10th, now stands at \$22,406.83.

Moving forward, all roof designated contributions will be applied to the principal balance of the loan, and the roof expense chart in the fellowship hall will be updated accordingly.

Thank you, ALL, for your continued efforts in reducing this expense.


