Now there was a Pharisee named Nicodemus, a leader of the Jews. He came to Jesus by night and said to him, "Rabbi, we know that you are a teacher who has come from God, for no one can do these signs that you do unless God is with that person." -John 3:1-2

In February, I started a program called Faith and Lead. The focus is looking at how congregations identity challenges in ministry. The interesting perspective of this program is moving away from finding a "solution" to asking questions of pondering that allows opportunities to develop. Much like Nicodemus that came before our Jesus in the night, we too have those opportunities to ask those questions of wondering and pondering that leads to learning more about each other and the community around us. As our ministries take a pause until September, it allows us the ability to ask questions and ponder.

Here is some questions I find myself curious about and would love to hear what are some of yours?

- * What are the needs of our community that could be met if we joined in mission together?
- * Do we know how to better support families? What are ways that we could help support parents?
- * What are the needs of our older members?
- * Are there health, transportation, or mobility needs we are not aware of?
- * How do we learn more about each other? As individuals and as congregations?
- * What are the stories and experiences that we share? How do we grow our relationships?
- * How do we plant those seeds of trust and opportunity to be able to share those stories?

The concrete cross was ordered by Patti B and Connie N to beautify our church property. It was paid for with funds donated by our former WELCA group.




