WELCOME BACK!


We are super excited to kick off our Sunday School season on **Sunday, September 7, 2025.**










Many thanks to Taylor T for helping the Parish Ed Committee decorate the church like an under sea adventure.



Trinity Evangelical Lutheran Church Council Meeting Summary August 11, 2025

Treasurer's Report – May-July 2025

General Fund: \$13,226.01 Memorial Fund: \$188,801.38–includes value of 3 CDs=\$157,023.14

Income: \$41,534.85 Expenses: \$26,234.33

Pastor's Report

- Pastor will be attending the Annual Theological Conference October 12th-15th (Monday-Wednesday) in Door County.
- Pastor will be taking vacation September 24th-October 4th.
- Pastor followed up with Compassus (hospice care center). They are looking to come to Trinity in September and give a speech about hospice and what services they provide.
- Trunk or Treat event-Pastor would still like to look at this as a possibility for this Halloween.

Old Business

- Time & Talent Survey-Survey draft will be updated and reviewed again at the September meeting. Tentative date to send out to congregation will be in October.
- Summer Joint Worship Service-Had 120 people in attendance. Ideas for next year include setting up the chairs for worship in a different formation (on grass-in shade). Band was good and food was great (pulled pork)!

New Business

- Insurance Renewal update Insurance policy cost for 2024 was \$12,120 and it is going up to \$17,585 for 2025.
- Communion bread Starting in September we'll go back to homemade bread verse communion wafers.
- · Communion Chalice will explore options for a new chalice and discuss it at meeting in September
- Property Committee review Perry, Denny and Pastor Will have been mowing the lawn this summer-the time commitment is too great for just 3 people. Need to discuss changes for next year.
- Discussion of remodeling of sacristy to include a sink for washing communion ware. Will need to look at getting a cost estimate.
- Blessing of Animals service on Sunday, September 21st at 4:00 pm.
