These words are from our upcoming Gospel reading for Ash Wednesday service this month. Jesus spoke these words as he was lifting up the ideals of prayer and giving of one's heart. If you are like most people in this world today, we are struggling with that. It is not because we don't want to give of our hearts, but our hearts are tired, broken, and crying out for their own healing. We have walked through hardship, heartache, and grief for many years now. To give of one's heart in such fragile and vulnerable times almost seems harder to do than it once was. We come to the cross this year feeling bound by the world's expectations in search of treasure while our hearts just want the richness of kindness, mercy, love, acceptance, and peace...that everlasting and all-consuming peace.

Lent is a time where we turn our faith and heart towards the cross for a time of reflection, a time of renewal, and a time of salvation. This year, we will be journeying through the scriptures with the Gospel of John and alongside the Genesis story of Joseph in a series called *Unbound: Longing for Wholeness*. Here is a brief introduction of this series and I hope you too will find that peace this Lenten season.

Unbound: Longing for Wholeness

*What if the opposite of being bound is being whole?
Our world is filled with things that hold us captive.
These things that bind us prevent us from living the
whole, abundant life that God has promised us.
Through the stories of regular people encountering
Jesus, and being drawn to the wholeness that Jesus
provides, we can learn about our own longings and be

Trinity Council has looked into the possibility of placing an AED in our church for the safety of our congregation members. One of the suggestions for funding the AED, which has a cost of between \$1,500 and \$2,100, depending on the model selected; was to inform our congregation members who have Thrivent accounts of their opportunity to select Trinity as the destination of their "Choice Dollars" with Thrivent.

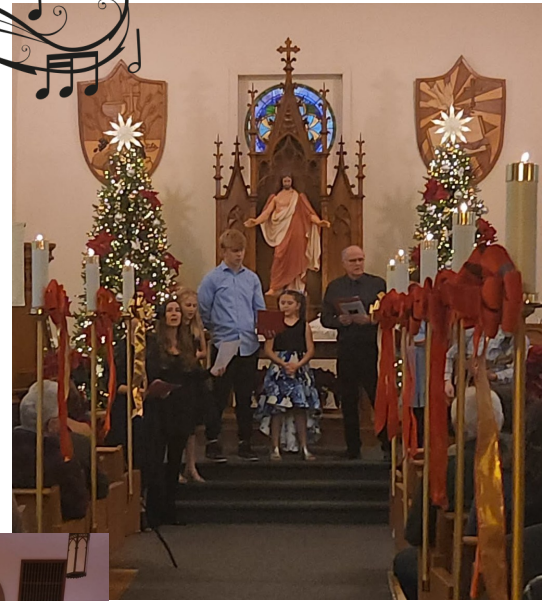

The Annual Meeting survey results regarding the inquiries for the questions pertaining to “Additional Summer Joint Worship Services” and “Mid-week Lenten Services” for our membership were reviewed. Though the surveys will be discussed in more detail at our next council meetings, we believed it important to let all our membership know the results of these two questions through the newsletter.

Upon combining the survey data for both parishes, there was an overwhelming support for us to continue the Wednesday evening Lenten Services. We will continue with the Lenten service schedule found within the newsletter.

The results of the additional summer worship services are not as clear since St. Peter supported the idea of hosting a joint service in the summer while Trinity results were more divided. Therefore, the councils will review the information and communicate a decision based on these results at the next joint council meeting on February 10th.

Old Business:

- CONSTITUTION & BYLAWS UPDATE - Discussed recommendations received thus far from congregation. Some spelling errors and things to consider regarding individual committees. It can be noted in the Constitution and Bylaws to refer to Christmas Committee list and do not need to spell everything out as this is a living resolution and always editable without needing to be re-approved from the Synod. Plan to reach out to each committee to have them provide to council a list of duties they keep track of.
- SUMMER JOINT WORSHIP SERVICE - Regarding outdoor joint worship service, will bring up at annual meeting that we are looking for 2-3 people for planning team.
- LENTEN SERVICE - Will consider paper ballot for recommendations at the annual meeting.

New Business:

- CARPORT - Discussed use of orange (no parking) cone in winter months and will leave up to greeter's discretion on use. Also discussed adding signage to the car port noting the low clearance (it's about 9 feet). Just a note for future - If need for ambulance, they won't fit under the car port.
- SUMMER FLOWERS/DECORATIONS - Discussed purchasing planters and flowers for the exterior of church by the front door, will look to do this in the future.
